

5. PARAJE NATURAL DEL RIO GUADALHORCE

6. SIERRA LOJA

Rise to 1300+ mts. above sea level and experience the changes in habitats that give support to numerous birds. We will drive, stop, walk then drive etc. again, so it's not a strenuous climb!! Stunning views!!

Rock Sparrows and Buntings, Black Wheatears, Choughs, Bonelli's Eagle, Lesser Kestrel, Rock Thrush all possible if the season is right.

Bird watching for all levels of interest

Plan a day's birding adventure into your Spanish holiday!

1. LAGUNAS DE ARCHIDONA

Watch Bee Eater's aeronautics as they catch dragonflies, bees and insects above the surface of La Grande Laguna, Archidona.



Also Ducks, Herons and Black Redstarts, Hoopoes, raptors, Warblers and Woodchat Shrikes.

A good half day trip.

2. FLAMINGOS GALORE!

Visit Fuente de Piedra and see one of Europe's largest breeding colonies of Greater Flamingos.

Many other waders, raptors and small birds to be seen.

A telescope is a MUST, so let us bring ours and help you get the best out of your visit.



3. VULTURES AND WEIRD ROCK SHAPES

Watch Griffon Vultures ride the thermals above El Torcal, Europe's most important Karstic formations.

See Blue Rock Thrushes, Choughs and if the season is right, Sub Alpine and Melodious Warblers, plus many more species.



4. LA HOZ DEL ARROYO MARIN

Walk through the streambed valley and back watching for birds in the glades and rock escarpments.



In spring and early summer there are Nightingales on virtually every tree!

Summer visiting Golden Orioles; Warblers; Red-rumped Swallows; many Butterflies and flowers.
